Cell Counting Kit-8 is a viability and proliferation assay test solution. It is a supplied as a ready-to-use 1-bottle solution (5 mL; 500 tests) and enables the colorimetric determination of the number of viable cells in cell proliferation and cytotoxicity assays. Cell Counting Kit-8 utilizes a highly water-soluble tetrazolium salt (WST-8), which is reduced by cellular dehydrogenases to an orange formazan dye. The color change can be detected in the 430 - 490 nm range and Cell Counting Kit-8 exhibits improved sensitivity compared with other tetrazolium salt-based assays such as MTT, XTT or MTS. Stability and Solubility Advice:

Some solutions can be difficult to obtain and can be encouraged by rapid stirring, sonication or gentle warming (in a 45-60°C water bath).

Information concerning product stability, particularly in solution, has rarely been reported and in most cases we can only offer a general guide. *Unless contradicted by product-specific protocols or instructions, our standard recommendations apply:

SOLIDS: Provided storage is as stated on the product label and the vial is kept tightly sealed, the product can be stored for up to 6 months from date of receipt.

SOLUTIONS: We recommend that stock solutions, once prepared, are stored aliquoted in tightly sealed vials at -20°C or below and used within 1 month. Wherever possible solutions should be made up and used on the same day.
