CELT-426 is a potent and partially selective fluorescent hD<sub>2</sub> dopamine receptor antagonist (K<sub>i</sub> values are 89.3 nM, 194.8 nM, and 263.6 nM for D<sub>2</sub>, D<sub>3</sub>, and D<sub>4</sub> dopamine receptors respectively in radioligand binding assay). CELT-426 can be used as a fluorescent dopamine receptor probe for fluorescence binding assays, live cell imaging, flow cytometry, and fluorescence polarization assays. It is a suitable replacement for GPCR radiolabeling ligands. Excitation and emission maxima (λ) are 560 and 571 nm, respectively. **Solubility & Usage Info:**

This product is supplied as a lyophilized solid and may be very hard to visualize. Solutions should be made by adding solvent directly to the vial. The vial should then be vortexed vigorously to ensure the product has completely dissolved.

**Stability and Solubility Advice:**

Some solutions can be difficult to obtain and can be encouraged by rapid stirring, sonication or gentle warming (in a 45-60°C water bath).

Information concerning product stability, particularly in solution, has rarely been reported and in most cases we can only offer a general guide. \*Unless contradicted by product-specific protocols or instructions, our standard recommendations apply:

SOLIDS: Provided storage is as stated on the product label and the vial is kept tightly sealed, the product can be stored for up to 6 months from date of receipt.

SOLUTIONS: We recommend that stock solutions, once prepared, are stored aliquoted in tightly sealed vials at -20°C or below and used within 1 month. Wherever possible solutions should be made up and used on the same day.
